Michelle served in the Peace Corps in Guyana teaching 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and then lived in India for 3 years. Jamie traveled through Asia after finishing Law School and met her Swiss husband while they both worked in Tokyo. Michelle now resides in Orlando, FL managing a restaurant at Universal Studios and Jamie lives in Siebnen, Switzerland with her husband Oliver and their first child Fritz. Along the way, Mike and Lorraine have indulged their hobby of antique collecting for the Victorian-style home they built, Mike's rideable steam train, the "LuluBelle", with accompanying layout and village, restoring old cars, keeping chickens and travel. They happily retired from their jobs in 2004 and then in 2010, returned to square dancing, this time with the Buckles and Bows. They have held several board positions and met wonderful, lifelong friends in the Club. They plan to stay active members for the duration!
