



Our club is teaching the New Dancers SSD program on Tuesday nights. Twice a year the class opens for students to start at the entry level. Parallel with the SSD classes, we are holding SSD level dances in addition to our regular club dances that alternate SSD and Plus level tips. The idea is to get students to start attending dances, without them having to master the entire list of 100 calls. Nearly a hundred dancers attended our first SSD dance Feb. 13th.
