There were 33 different athletic events taking place that week and the following week. We were to be athletes in square dancing. We learned about the event from Mike Seastrom, who for his first time was one of four callers along with Buddy Weaver, Jerry Junck, and Tony Oxendine.

We checked in on Monday morning at the convention center which was lined with international flags, just like at the Olympics. We received name tags, T-shirts, and \$10 off at both the gift store (where we immediately headed) and the food trucks.

Dancing took place at two different locations in nearby Hurricane which we learned is pronounced her-e-kin by the locals. Mainstream and Plus were in one building and Advanced/C-1 in another. The evening dances included round dancing. There were three sessions of dancing on Monday, the competitions on Tuesday morning, dancing that afternoon, and the opening ceremonies that evening. There was more dancing Wednesday morning and evening and Thursday morning followed by the medal presentation. In addition, at the opening ceremony there was a pizza party preceding the parade of athletes into the arena, where we were impressively entertained, and an outdoor festival later in the week where the food trucks were located along with tables to eat and live entertainment.
