

New Dancers Class a New Way to 'Square Up' at Tuesday Class

We are using a new way to spread new dancers around the dance floor. As new dancers sign in they are given a name tag with a square number. Square numbers start at the front of the hall (1,2,3) and finish in the back (10,11,12). As a tip is starting, new dancers should go to the 'side' positions of their square. Angels should then fill in the 'head' spots. Angels helping with the "SOLO" board should go to their assigned square to meet their 'new dancer' partner.

It may seem complicated; but the goal is to avoid squares with 7 or 8 angels and another square where all the dancers are new. To cover the squares we need a few more angels.






